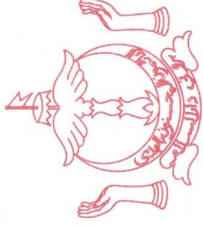

AIRWORTHINESS INFORMATION NOTICE(AIN) No.005 :
INTRODUCTION OF BRUNEI AVIATION REQUIREMENT (BAR) PART- M

The Brunei Department of Civil Aviation, Airworthiness Section has produced an Airworthiness Information Notice No:005 to inform operators and maintenance organisations of the introduction of BAR Part M as part of upgrading the existing Continuing Airworthiness under JAR OPS Sub Part-M requirement.

The Civil Aviation Authorities of South East Asian Regional Initiative (SEARIF) members have agreed to a common comprehensive and detailed aviation requirements, with a view to make it compatible for Continuing Airworthiness carried out in one Member State to be acceptable by the Civil Aviation Authority in another Member States.

The SEARIF Part M has been developed based on EASA Part M (EC Regulation 2042/2003 including amendments up to 127/2010 and EASA ED 2003/19/RM including amendment up to 1010/002/R) with appropriate customization for the need of Member State Countries.

The BAR Part M will be based on SEARIF Part M, Continuing Airworthiness Requirements, established technical requirements and administrative procedures for ensuring the continuing airworthiness of aircraft, including any component for installation thereto which are applicable to large aircraft and aircraft used in Commercial Operation registered in Brunei Darussalam.

The BAR Part M will be issued in March 2014 and all related activities have been submitted to Brunei Aircraft operators as per the published Roadmap. The existing AOC holders and operators of large aircrafts must obtain M.A.Subpart G approval by 31 July 2015, at the latest.

Please make sure that the information contained in the AIN is circulated to the personnel in your organisation to whom they apply.
