- e. Original Noise Certificate.
- f. AIR Form 60, if the aircraft is to be exported to foreign country
- g. Documented / Photographic evidence of the removal of registration marks and fireproof registration plate
- h. Documented evidence of the cancellation of Brunei allocated Mode 'S' transponder coding.
- i. Evidence of deletion of the 406 MHz Emergency Locator Transponder Code.

IMPORTANT: Subject to satisfactory review of the application and supporting documents, the deregistration may take up to twenty (20) working days excluding time required for the issuance of other certificates (Export Airworthiness Statement, etc.) that may take place during the process of deregistration
