Penetration of Corridor by Transit Aircraft. Brunei APP will coordinate any flights wishing to penetrate the SRA with ANDUKI Tower. Helicopters operating within the area defined in Col. 1 from ground/sea level up to and including 2000ft will be provided with FIS by ANDUKI Tower on 122.1 MHz. 2. Above 2000ft and within the area defined in Col.1 FIS will be provided by Brunei APP on 121.3 MHz. Controlling Authority: Brunei Approach.

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
