DC.1 Introduction

DC.1.1 For the purpose of complying with the Brunei Darussalam's obligations under articles 12 and 37 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, done at Chicago on 7 December 1944 (the Convention), as implemented in Brunei Darussalam by the Civil Aviation Order 2006 and Civil Aviation Regulations 2006, and in accordance with Annex 9 to the Convention, the Director of the Brunei DCA hereby adopts as Requirements under regulation 91(1) of the Civil Aviation Regulations 2006 the Standards and Recommended Practices, together with such of the Definitions contained in the said Annex that are not otherwise decreed. In accordance with article 38 to the Convention, any differences between this BAR 9 – FACILITATION and the Annex 9 Standards and Recommended Practices shall be notified to the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) and published in the Brunei Darussalam Aeronautical Information Publication.

DC.2 Authority for this Regulation

DC.2.1 This BAR 9 – FACILITATION is issued on the authority of the Director of Civil Aviation.

DC.3 Applicability

DC.3.1 This BAR 9 – FACILITATION is applicable to the aviation industry of the Brunei Darussalam.

DC.4 Scope

DC.4.1 This BAR 9 establishes the basic requirements to be met for international civil aviation operations in Brunei Darussalam, and demonstrates compliance with ICAO Annexes.

DC.5 Definitions

DC.5.1 Terms shall have the meaning given to them in the relevant legal instruments or international legal instruments in which they appear, especially as they appear in the Convention and its Annexes.
